In this privacy policy, we want to clearly explain what information we collect, how we use it, and what rights you have in relation to it. Please take some time to read through it, as it is important. If there are any terms in this privacy policy that you do not agree with, please discontinue use of our Product.

This privacy policy applies to all information collected through our website(s) or Product and any related services, sales, marketing or events (collectively “Products”). Please read this privacy policy carefully so you can make informed decisions about sharing your personal information with us.

1. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT FROM?

In Short: We collect Demographic Information and Personal Information, as defined below, and mostly you.

We collect Demographic Information including your sex, geo-location data, masjid preferences (hereinafter “Demographic Information”). We also collect and retain your name, email address, mailing address, and image you set as a profile picture (“Personal Information”). We do not collect information from other sources. In addition, if you post any content in the Product or in the marketplace in the Product, we retain that information as well.

Information automatically collected

In Short: We collect your geo-location.

We automatically collect your geo-location, which is based on your phone’s location data when you use our Product. This information does not reveal your specific identity (like your name or contact information) but may include device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name, country, location, information about how and when you use and other technical information. This information is used to inform our Demographic Information and also is needed to maintain the security and operation of our Product, and for our internal analytics and reporting purposes. We do not collect information from other sources.

2. HOW DO WE USE YOUR INFORMATION?

In Short: We process your information for purposes based on legitimate business interests, the fulfillment of our services for you. We do not sell or share your Personal Information or Demographic data.

We analyze your Demographic Information in order to learn behavior about sets of demographics and sell the analyses to third parties. We collect your Personal Information but only retain it for limited durations and to carry out the purpose of the Application. We do not sell or share your Personal Information with third parties or Demographic data outside of the aggregate data. We use the information we collect or receive:

- To send administrative information to you. We may use your personal information to send you product, service and new feature information and/or information about changes to our terms, conditions, and policies.
- Deliver targeted advertising to you. We may use your information to develop and display content and advertising (and work with third parties who do so) tailored to your interests and/or location and to measure its effectiveness.

- To protect our Product. We may use your information as part of our efforts to keep our Product safe and secure (for example, for fraud monitoring and prevention).
- To enforce our terms, conditions and policies.
- To respond to legal requests and prevent harm. If we receive a subpoena or other legal request, we may need to inspect the data we hold to determine how to respond.
- For other business purposes. We may use your information for other business purposes such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve our Product, services, marketing, and your experience.

3. WILL YOUR INFORMATION BE SHARED WITH ANYONE?

In Short: We share information with your consent, to comply with laws, to protect your rights, or to fulfill business obligations. We also use your information to create aggregate data as explained above.

We may process or share data based on the following legal bases:

- **Consent:** We may process your data if you have given us specific consent to use your personal information in a specific purpose.
- **Legitimate Interests:** We may process your data when it is reasonably necessary to achieve our legitimate business interests.
- **Performance of a Contract:** Where we have entered into a contract with you, we may process your personal information to fulfill the terms of our contract.
- **Legal Obligations:** We may disclose your information where we are legally required to do so in order to comply with applicable law, governmental requests, a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process, such as in response to a court order or a subpoena (including in response to public authorities to meet national security or law enforcement requirements).
- **Vital Interests:** We may disclose your information where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.
- **Vendors, Consultants and Other Third-Party Service Providers:** We may share your Demographic and Personal Information with third party vendors, service providers,

contractors or agents who perform services for us or on our behalf and require access to such information to do that work. Examples include: data analysis, email delivery, hosting services, customer service and marketing efforts. We may allow selected third parties to use tracking technology on our Product, which will enable them to collect data about how you interact with our Product over time. This information may be used to, among other things, analyze and track data, determine the popularity of certain content and better understand online activity.

- **Business Transfers:** We may share or transfer your information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.

4. WHO WILL YOUR INFORMATION BE SHARED WITH?

***In Short:** We only share information with the following third parties.*

We share your Demographic Information with various parties who we contract with to provide virtual audiences (“Vendors”), entities that sell sports products, and will vary from time to time. We only share and disclose your Personal Information with the third parties listed below. We have categorized each party so that you may easily understand the purpose of our data collection and processing practices. If we have processed your data based on your consent and you wish to revoke your consent, please contact us. “Demographic Information” is defined as age, sex, gender, geo-location data, and the types of events you attend. “Personal Information” is defined as your name, phone number, and email address. 5. DO WE USE COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES?

***In Short:** We may use cookies and other tracking technologies to collect and store your information.*

6. IS YOUR INFORMATION TRANSFERRED INTERNATIONALLY?

In Short: We may transfer, store, and process your information in countries other than your own. Our servers are located in United States.

If you are accessing our Product from outside United States, please be aware that your information may be transferred to, stored, and processed by us in our facilities and by those third parties with whom we may share your personal information (see “[WILL YOUR INFORMATION BE SHARED WITH ANYONE?](#)” above), in United States, and other countries.

If you are a resident in the European Economic Area, note that other countries may not have data protection or other laws as comprehensive as those in your country. We will however take all necessary measures to protect your personal information in accordance with this privacy policy and applicable law.

7. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

In Short: We keep your Demographic Information for an indefinite amount of time or until you revoke consent. We keep your Personal Information only as long as your permissions allow us to or when, if applicable, you revoke your consent.

We will only keep your Personal Information for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law (such as tax, accounting or other legal requirements). No purpose in this policy will require us keeping your personal information for longer than 18 months past the termination of the user's account.

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your Personal Information, we will either delete or anonymize it, or, if this is not possible (for example, because your Personal Information has been stored in backup archives), then we will securely store your personal information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible.

We keep your Demographic Information for an indefinite amount of time or until you revoke consent. However, we cannot recall any Demographic Information once it is sold or transferred to third parties and revocation of your consent does not apply to Demographic Information previously held, sold, or shared.

8. HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SAFE?

In Short: We aim to protect your personal information through a system of organizational and technical security measures.

We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational security measures designed to protect the security of any personal information we process and use reputable providers. However, please also remember that we cannot guarantee that the internet itself is 100% secure. Although

we will do our best to protect your personal information, transmission of personal information to and from our Product is at your own risk. You should only access the services within a secure environment.

9. DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM MINORS?

In Short: *We do not knowingly collect or process data from or market to children under 16 years of age.*

We do not knowingly solicit data from or market to children under 13 years of age. By using our Product, you represent that you are at least 13 years old. If we learn that personal information from users less than 13 years of age has been collected, we will deactivate the account and take reasonable measures to promptly delete such data from our records. 10. WHAT ARE YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS?

In Short: *In some regions, such as the European Economic Area or United Kingdom, you have rights that allow you greater access to and control over your personal information. You may review, change, or terminate your account at any time.*

In some regions (like the European Economic Area and the United Kingdom), you have certain rights under applicable data protection laws. These may include the right (i) to request access and obtain a copy of your personal information, (ii) to request rectification or erasure; (iii) to restrict the processing of your personal information; and (iv) if applicable, to data portability. We will consider and act upon any request in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

If we are relying on your consent to process your Personal Information and Demographic Information, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Please note however that this will not affect the lawfulness of the processing before its withdrawal.

If you are resident in the European Economic Area and you believe we are unlawfully processing your personal information, you also have the right to complain to your local data protection supervisory authority.

11. HOW CAN YOU REVIEW, UPDATE, OR DELETE THE DATA WE COLLECT FROM YOU?
